Legislative News

HB1378 passed in the 2009 Legislative Session and was signed by Governor Hoeven on April 21st, 2009.

HB1378 (ND Century Code 15.1-060-1) will move the birthday cut-off date to August 1st and it will be implemented summer of 2010.

The new law states that: *Children must be five years old before August 1st to enter kindergarten.
